What is a Registered LNR?

A Registered LNR (Registered Licence Not Required) Child Care Provider is someone who provides care for up to two children who:

- are other than their own children in their home
- are either occasionally, part time, or full time in your care
- can be related to you—such as nieces, nephews, or grandchildren
- are in your care during daytime hours or before or after school
- and, you meet the Provincial government registration requirements with your regional Child Care Resource and Referral
