Job Summary:

The Mental Health Clinician is responsible for providing mental health clinical assessment and treatment services to the public requiring mental health services and brief psychotherapy.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Maintains client caseload based on referrals from the community.
2. Completes intake and clinical assessment of all clients in a timely manner.
3. Develops and implements therapeutic plans for each client.
4. Provides short term individual treatment interventions as per the therapeutic plans for each client.

Employees interested in applying for the above position should submit their name and resume to Human Resources within seven calendar days of this posting.

5. Maintains effective relationships with Government bodies and community partners as they pertain to the program.
6. Maintains statistical data on clients as required by the program manager.
7. Attends team meetings, training days and the SFRS Annual General Meeting.
8. Maintains knowledge of available programs, their interrelationships, and their function in delivering care in the community to persons with mental illness, addictions and/or concurrent disorders.
9. Maintains Knowledge of psychiatric disorders and relevant legislative acts (such as the Mental Health Act).
