Single Session, Same-Day Services

Anyone, including family and care givers, can come in or call in to Sooke Family Resource Society for single session therapy. Sessions will focus on any challenges you are facing that day, including providing referrals, therapy or connection to community services.

What we do

- We provide a single counselling session to address immediate concerns. It is a program for anyone 19 years and older experiencing a mental health issue or other challenge and needs to see a counsellor as soon as possible.
- There is no fee for this service.
